Book the date and Church in the Parish office.

Invite a Priest to be Celebrant.

Contact the Civil Registration Office not later than 3 Months before the Wedding date ( Rooskey, Monaghan Town) ( 047 – 30444)

Organise pre- marriage course , the Diocese of Clogher recommend "Accord" ( 047 -83359)

Arrange with the priest celebrant to have the required Marriage papers filled in at least three months prior to the wedding. Those living outside the Parish normally have their papers prepared by their local priest who will forward them to the celebrant.

Papers normally required:

Baptismal Cert

Confirmation Cert

Letter(s) of Freedom

Pre-nuptial Enquiry Form
