Mass of Chrism

For the first time since 2016 we will celebrate a Mass of Chrism in the Cathedral on this Holy Thursday. You are invited to join Bishop Larry and the people of our Diocese in this celebration **on Holy Thursday, 18 April 2019 at 11am in St Macartan's Cathedral, Monaghan**. The Mass of Chrism is a gathering of the entire diocese, bishop, priests, deacons, religious and lay faithful. It is an occasion during which the bishop blesses the holy oils and consecrates the oil of chrism. These will be used in the celebration of the sacraments in the year ahead. At the Mass, the priests will also renew their promises to serve God and his people. The two oils that are blessed at the Chrism Mass: that of the sick and that of catechumens are then used, in the year ahead wherever there is a sacramental anointing, such as the anointing of the sick, the anointing of those to be baptized. The oil of chrism is consecrated for use in the anointing of those being confirmed in our parishes. It will also be used to anoint Deacon Kevin Connolly when he will be ordained to the priesthood on 30 June next.
