Martin has been active in parish ministry throughout his life. He has served as chairperson of the Parish Pastoral Council of St Michael's Parish, Enniskillen and Lisbellaw and is the current Carrickmacross Cemetery Council has a position chairperson of the Clogher Diocesan Liturgy Commission. He has been assigned to minister in the Enniskillen Pastoral Area (Enniskillen & Tempo parishes). Today, he will be ordained in St Michael's Church, Enniskillen, by the Bishop of Raphoe, Most Rev.
