Organise pre- marriage course , the Diocese of Clogher recommend "Accord" (047 -83359).

Arrange with the priest celebrant to have the required Marriage papers filled in at least three months prior to the wedding. Those living away from home, should have papers prepared by the Priest of their residing Parish
