Some Liturgical Advice for Readers

Don't say First Reading, **But** - A reading from.....

When reading is concluded, leave a little pause, then say **The Word of the Lord and not** This is the Word of the Lord.

Responsorial Psalm

For the Psalm, always introduce it by saying **Our Response is.....** and repeat it so that the people can remember it. At the end of each verse **don't say , Our Response is.....** Just pause and let the people respond naturally, but again if it is a long response or a difficult one, you may repeat it with the people
