Weekly Reflection.

'Are you the one?'

John the Baptist is described by Jesus in the most glowing of terms 'Of all the children born of women, there's no one greater than John.' High praise indeed. After all, John was the cousin of Jesus chosen by God to prepare the way for Jesus.

Yet, he is now in prison and maybe he is not so certain about Jesus, so he sends his disciples to pose the question, 'Are you the one who is to come, or have we to wait for another?' It is a question borne out of the doubts and anguish he is experiencing in the darkness of his prison cell.

There are times in our lives when our faith is tested, when our hope seems shattered, when it is hard to cling on to the belief we have in a loving God. Even the greatest of all the saints, John the Baptist had troubled times.

John's response was to turn again to Jesus to seek reassurance. He did not expect miracles, nor do we. But like John in our darkest moments, we will get the courage to keep going, with faith renewed.
