## **Weekly Reflection.**

### **Catholic Schools Week**

The theme for Catholic Schools Week is – 'Normal lives, called to holiness.' Most of us are familiar with the exemplary life of the student Carlos Acutis, who through his devotion to the Eucharist inspired so many young people along the path of faith. The late Pope Francis when speaking of Blessed Carlos said, 'holiness does not mean doing extraordinary things, but doing ordinary things with love and faith.' He will be the first teenage saint of our times, and an example to all generations of holiness.

Holiness begins in prayer where our personal relationship with God develops in the rituals of the Church, especially in Sunday Eucharist. The Eucharist nourishes and enables us to be people of service and courage, joy, and mission. Holiness is not an achievement; it is a gift that is offered to each one of us.

Catholic schools are special communities where staff and students discover that our lives matter for in the words of St Paul we hear 'that the life of each one of us has its influence on others.'

As we close the celebration of Catholic Schools Week, we pray that our schools may be places of faith and charity, where the witness of Blessed Carlos Acutis may be the inspiration that turns ordinary lives to holiness.

These Masses will rotate on a yearly basis from the 1<sup>st</sup> weekend of Lent each year if we have two priests in the Parish.


