#### Weekly Reflection.

#### **'A Sombre Silence'**

On Saturday morning last as we assembled to celebrate the funeral Mass for Chloe McGee, I was struck by the sombre silence of the hundreds of people, young and old, who assembled in the Church, in the carpark, along the streets in the guards-of-honour, in the huge cortege that followed Chloe's coffin from Barnadonagh, to St. Joseph's Church. It was a deeply respectful silence, and carried a reluctance even to whisper, in case the fragile and delicate sense of grief which enveloped us, could be shattered. From the youthful tears of the Altar Servers to the stoic tears of the elderly neighbours, standing to attention on the Shercock Road, as the hearse passed their homes, all generations were as one with the traditional values of 'auld decency,' being handed on to the next generations. The intergenerational context of reverence for ritual and religion were evident as constitutional duty brought Uachtaran na hEireann to Carrickmacross, while the young adults were reacquainted with the melody of our liturgies, where they may have forgotten some of the words, but remembered the airs surrounding the practice of our faith in such testing circumstances.

The tragedy of the accident crossed all boundaries. Five families forever united in grief, four adjacent parishes numbed with the shocking loss of life, an almost impenetrable fog of devastation drifting across three counties and three dioceses, reaching across the Irish Sea to Lanarkshire, in Scotland. As we listened to parents speaking of sleepless nights, and grandparents wondering whether their grandkids would be safe, we took cognisance of the extraordinary resilience of the first responders, and were assured of heartfelt prayers for the families from the length and breadth of the country, Archbishop John Mc Dowell, the Church of Ireland Archbishop of Armagh spoke to me of holding all of us in his mind and prayers, and our own Bishops and clergy brought the comforting compassion of Christ both to the family homes and to the Funeral Masses.

Our faith is central to our lives as we endeavour to walk the dark road of grief with the families involved. 'The souls of the virtuous are in the hands of God, no torment will ever touch them.' As we begin our Advent journey today, we offer the grieving parents and siblings the assurance of our prayerful presence in the lonely times ahead.
