#### **Weekly Reflection.**

#### The Lord's purifying work.

In today's Gospel Jesus says, **'Stop turning my Father's house into a market.'** There is a big difference between a house and a market. A house has the potential to be a home. A market could never really be a home; people go to markets to buy and sell. Buying and selling are not activities you associate with home. The temple was to be God's house, God's home, a place where all people could feel at home in God's presence. The activities associated with the market were preventing the temple from being the home that God wanted it to be, a spiritual home for all. Jesus saw that here was an institution in need of reform.

In every generation, our own included, Jesus will always be working to purify and renew us. In the light of today's Gospel reading we might ask ourselves in what ways we have allowed the values of the marketplace to override the values of the Gospel in our own lives, in the life of our society, in the life of our church.
