Weekly Reflection.

'What are you afraid of?'

2000 years ago, the Apostles had locked themselves in the room for fear of the Jews. Having witnessed (from a safe distance) the crucifixion and death of their leader, they were scared that they could be next to receive that same fate. Fear paralyzed them, and it was only with the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost that these frightened individuals became the fearless witnesses to the resurrection of Jesus.

Fear is the great plague of our age and all of us are sufferers. We are afraid of letting other people know who we are, so we put on masks that protect us from being hurt. We are afraid to trust in case our inadequacies are exposed. We are afraid of what others might think or say about us. We fear for the future in a world that seems to have gone crazy, hell-bent on self-destruction. Our health professionals are overwhelmed when we present our worries, anxieties, our stresses and tensions and often they are at a loss when we are crippled by our fear of failure.

Pentecost was not a once-off event putting courage in the Apostles, when the power of the Holy Spirit brought healing, hope and courage. The same Spirit is available to you and me today. When the challenges that come our way are great, we should simply pray

'Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful, enkindle in us the fire of your love, send forth your Spirit and renew the face of the earth.'
