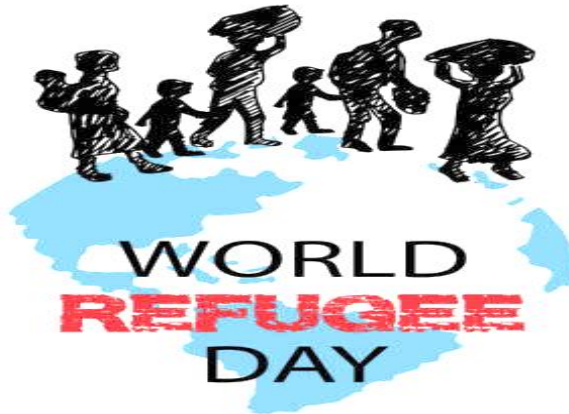

## **Weekly Reflection.**

### **The Sin of Indifference**

Today's readings warn us against the sin of indifference. This is a lack of interest and disregard for God, His commands, and the needs of others. In the first reading, the prophet Amos denounces the people who care only about themselves but do not care about the fallen house of Joseph. The gospel presents us with a similar attitude in the parable of the rich man and Lazarus. We are not told the specific sin of the rich man. He did not order that Lazarus be taken away from his gate. Neither did he purposefully mistreat him. The sin he committed was not noticing Lazarus. He considered Lazarus a natural part of the environment and believed it was inevitable that he would lie in pain and hunger while he lived in luxury. So, it wasn't what he did that sent him to hell, but what he failed to do. It is necessary and our Christian duty to actively take action to alleviate the situation of others and to resist tyranny and injustice, even if we are not directly affected.
