Weekly Reflection

"Let's make a difference."

Most of us agree that the Church in our country has come through some very challenging times in the last twenty years or so. The scandals of abuse and the mishandling of issues associated with them have rocked the foundations. Social changes in how people live their lives have also had a significant effect. It is fairly obvious that the practice of the Faith is not as strong as in the past. Doomsayers point to a continuing decline in attendance, while others moan and complain that somebody should do something about it; the somebody they speak of are the Bishops or priests or whoever, anyone in-fact but themselves.

If that had been the attitude of Mary then the Incarnation, the birth of Christ would not have happened. Mary took on a difficult challenge when she said "Yes" to the Angel Gabriel. To make a difference we do not have to go beyond our families and our communities. We can respond like Mary to the challenges presented to us by saying "Let what you have said be done". God asks us to be reconciled to our families and our neighbours.

If each one of us makes an effort, think of the difference that would make for all. Fr Shane
