Weekly Reflection.

Jesus' new commandment to love.

When Jesus says in today's gospel, 'I give you a **new** commandment: love one another; just as I have loved you, you also must love one another', we could easily say, 'What is **new** about this commandment? Doesn't the Old Testament, the Jewish scriptures, call on us to love our neighbour as ourselves? What is **new** in this commandment is the little phrase 'just as I have loved you. Jesus was the first human being to give full expression to God's love. His calling on us to love one another in the same divine way as he has loved is a **new** commandment.

Jesus also defined 'neighbour' in a **new** way. For Jesus, the neighbour was any and every member of the human race. We only have to think of the parable of the Good Samaritan. The broken man on the side of the road was a Jew. Yet, the Samaritan emptied himself in the service of this wounded and dying Jew, even though Jews were traditional enemies of the Samaritans. He revealed a love in action that did not discriminate. He demonstrated the kind of love that characterised the life of Jesus, a love that does not count the cost in the service of others, regardless of who they are. We need the Lord's help to love in this way, the help of the Holy Spirit.
