Weekly Reflection.

Use the gifts!

Over the past few months, I have had the privilege of celebrating the Sacrament of Confirmation in parishes around the diocese. I really enjoy the opportunity to talk with the young adults about elements of the sacrament, especially the gifts of the Holy Spirit. In all these instances the young people accept that if someone makes an effort and gives one a present, the worst response is to be ungrateful. What the giver really enjoys is if there is a genuine sense of gratitude for the gift, and the ultimate reward is for the recipient to actually make use of the present that has been given.

In the Gospel today Jesus assures his dejected followers that the Father will send the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, to teach them everything, to remind them of all He has said to them. The seven gifts of the Spirit are wisdom and understanding, right judgement and courage, knowledge and reverence, and wonder and awe in God's presence.

These gifts are given not just for use on the day of Confirmation. God has given each of us these wonderful presents for use every day. We must therefore not be ungrateful, but having given thanks, we should open them up and use them all the time.
