Weekly Reflection.

Firmly Anchored in Faith.

The Three-day Pilgrimage Season on Lough Derg for 2025 gets under way this weekend, with the first of the pilgrims arriving on Friday (May 30th).

Mgr La Flynn, Prior, writing in the Pilgrim's Friend (Friends of Lough Derg Newsletter - Spring /Summer edition) remarks that regular Lough Derg pilgrims will notice a new feature on the Island this year. Just a few metres from the main door of the Basilica where the threshold stone recalls the 2016 Jubilee of Mercy, they have displayed the **Anchor** taken from the now disused St. Patrick Boat, which itself can be seen near the visitor centre.

Fr La explains the significance of the **Anchor** - linking it with the Jubilee Year 2025, and its theme Pilgrims of Hope - citing Pope Francis, in his letter *Hope Does Not Disappoint*, formally proclaiming the Jubilee Year: "May we who have taken refuge in the Lord be strongly encouraged to seize the hope set before us. We have this hope, a sure and steadfast **anchor** of the soul...." Pope Francis goes on to comment: "The image of the **anchor** helps us to recognise the stability and security that is ours amid the troubled waters of this life, provided we entrust ourselves to the Lord Jesus. The storms that buffet us will never prevail, for we are firmly anchored in the hope born of grace."

Fr La's prayerful good wish for the Season 2025 is that both returning pilgrims and pilgrims coming to Lough Derg for the first time this summer as Pilgrims of Hope, will experience a deep connection with Christ our hope, together with others whose memory of past pilgrim journeys will offer hope and consolation to those who this year will make the journey in their hearts.

On this **Ascension Day**, we too pray God's Heavenly Blessing on Fr La & the Lough Derg Team as they generously minister to the pilgrims in this Jubilee Year 2025. Fr. Owen Joe.
