Weekly Reflection.

Bathed in the Light & Life of the Risen Lord.

If you were to find an image of the Christian life in today's Gospel reading, it would not be the sad journey of Mary Magdalene to the tomb in the darkness; it would be much more the excited running to the tomb of the beloved disciple and Peter in the early light or, even more so, the subsequent journey of Mary Magdalene who, having met the risen Lord, went to the disciples to announce, 'I have seen the Lord.'

Because of Easter, because of our conviction that in the person of Christ life has triumphed over death, we can approach with expectant faith whatever it might be in our life that seems like a tomb, trust that signs of new life are to found there. Because of Easter we know that even our darkest moments, our Golgotha experiences, are **bathed in the Light & Life of the Risen Lord.**
