#### Weekly Reflection.

#### "People can be very fickle!"

The people of Jerusalem were looking for a Messiah, a leader who would lead them to freedom from Roman occupation. They had heard that Jesus was a miracle worker and they reckoned he was their best bet to lead the revolution. When he arrived in Jerusalem he was welcomed like an all-conquering hero. Yet his plans did not match their short-term selfish ones. Within a few days they switched to Barrabas and demanded crucifixion for "the Christ".

This pattern has been repeated down the centuries. The "crowd" is always fickle, eager for excitement and something new; but quickly bored and easily distracted. Our personal lives can be similar. How often we seek the instant result, the quick moment of pleasure, only to become bored with the novelty and move on to something different.

Palm Sunday gives us the opportunity to re-examine our lives in terms of our relationship to Jesus. Is it a relationship that is fickle or casual or is it true faith? It is decision time.
