Weekly Reflection.

What is a vocation?

A vocation is not merely a career choice or a lifestyle. It is a deeper calling, an invitation from God which demands courage and humility. It demands a willingness to serve and to put one's own needs to second place. We often speak of the grace of a vocation, for it is through prayer and study over a period of discernment, the role God has chosen for an individual begins to unfold. St Therese of Lisieux says 'God does not call those who are worthy, but those whom He wills.

The Lord is calling men and women today to minister in His church. He speaks in whispers which are often drowned out by the noise of the world and its distractions. When He calls, He provides every gift and skill that is necessary.

Pope Francis spoke of the Joy of the Gospel being the source of fulfilment for those in ministry of service, as they grow in intimacy with Christ. On vocations Sunday we pray that those who are presently being called might respond with courage and generosity.

<u>Vocations Sunday</u>: The Fourth Sunday of Easter is known as Vocations Sunday or Good Shepherd Sunday and is marked as the World Day of Prayer for Vocations. The purpose of this day is to fulfil Jesus' instruction to "Pray the Lord of the harvest to send labourers into his harvest" (Matthew 9:38). While appreciating all vocations, the Church concentrates her attention on raising up shepherds for God's people - vocations to Holy Orders (the priesthood and diaconate) and to the religious life - while encouraging all who are discerning their vocation to pray more earnestly that they may hear and respond to God's call.
