Weekly Reflection.

'Stand Ready'

People tend to sit in the same pews each time they come to Mass. My family were no different. In the old church at home, we would all file into a pew where there happened to be a marble plaque on the wall, dedicated to a deceased priest from when the church was built. The plaque recalled his name and dates and concluded with the phrase from today's Gospel — 'stand ready, for you do not know the day or the hour.' As a child I found this to be a most frightening proposition. To my innocent eyes God was only really concerned with catching me out doing something wrong, like a cross teacher.

I learned since that these words are not so much a threat as an encouragement. When Jesus tells His disciples to stand ready, to keep awake, He is calling them to faithfulness every day, then there is no need to be afraid.

Give alms is Jesus' advice. It is good advice. When we are charitable in thought, word, and deed, then we have no fear of being caught out.
