#### 'The Fairytale of New York'

The recent death and funeral of singer Shane Mc Gowan has highlighted the song that he made famous with the late Kirsti Mac Coll; a song recognised all over the world as an alternative Christmas anthem. It paints a picture of the bleak despair of a couple of Irish emigrants in New York, where drink and drugs and depression take away any potential for joy or happiness in the city that never sleeps. The glitzy commercial image of the New York Christmas contrasts with the dark, isolated, and hopeless lives of the individuals whose dreams have been taken from them.

Our Advent journey today presents a different anthem. 'The people who walk in darkness have seen a great light'. People who endure the hardships of loneliness and helplessness now have reason to hope for our God has sent joyful messengers to prepare the way for His son. The paths will be straightened, the mountains will be laid low, and all who dream of better times will see the glory of God in a manger in a stable in Bethlehem.
