Weekly Reflection.

"Blessed are the peacemakers"

It is hard to believe that it is over 25 years since the Good Friday agreement was signed, promising an end to the Troubles and a new peace dividend for the shattered communities in the North.

Many of the architects of this peace have gone to their eternal reward. Fr Alec Reid, former Taoiseach Albert Reynolds, Northern Secretary Mo Mowlam, John Hume, Martin Mc Guinness and many others did so much to establish the Peace Process in Ireland. Their virtues of patience, perseverance and risk-taking have been rightly lauded, and we are all beneficiaries of the dialogue that was established by them.

These types of gifts are highlighted in today's Gospel, not at a national level, but at a personal, family and community level. The beautiful phrase "You have won your brother back!" highlights the importance of resolving differences with one another. Sometimes this will demand confrontation, sometimes it will need mediations - but even if it makes one feel uncomfortable, if we approach the challenge in humility we might just succeed.

There is a beautiful prayer included in Night Prayer of the Divine Office (priests' prayer book) from St Paul's letter to the Ephesians which says:

"Do not let resentment lead you into sin; the sunset must not find you still angry. Do not give the devil his opportunity"

St. Joseph's Cemetery - Sept '23 Update

As you will be aware, the first draft of our new 'Cemetery Display Board & Map' has been available to view in the front porch of St. Joseph's Church Carrickmacross since Thurs 29th June '23. In our July '23 update, we invited anyone who wished to make changes / additions, to do so by completing and signing an 'Alterations Form', which were made available from the Parish Office. The original cut-off date for making changes / additions was Fri 28th July '23, however this date was extended – the new cut-off date for changes / additions to the 'Display Board' is Thurs 14th Sept '23. You may also recall that in our May '23 update, the Cemetery Committee invited any individual / organisation who would like to 'adopt' one of this year's improvement projects, and fundraise for same, to contact the Committee Chairman Patrick Doherty. We are delighted to announce that two families responded to this call and have 'adopted' the Cemetery Display Board between them - this will be recognised on the Display Board when erected. The laurel hedge which surrounds a substantial portion of the Cemetery perimeter, will be trimmed and faced later on this month, while other general maintenance activities such as grass cutting and weed control are ongoing – these tasks were especially challenging this year given the very wet summer we experienced.

The Cemetery Committee would like to reinforce the message that, **"No Dogs or Pets are permitted in the Cemetery at any time"** – accordingly, signs have been erected throughout the Cemetery.
