Weekly Reflection.

`Corpus Christi – Symbol of God's love for us

When Jesus took bread and wine at the Last Supper and changed them into His body and blood, He gave us food for Life's journey. The food is symbolic of God's continuing love for us and our continuing need for God, and it has remained a focus in our lives through the centuries.

In Ireland during the dark days of the Penal Laws, priests under threat of death broke bread at Mass Rocks in sheltered glens, surrounded by people who risked their lives to attend the Eucharist. When we make our First Holy Communion, when couples get married, when funerals of our loved ones occur we turn to the Eucharist as the centre of the our Faith; to give meaning and significance to these special days in the lives of our families. When someone is ill, when young people are doing exams, when a myriad of special intentions are being offered, we turn to the Body and Blood of Christ to remind us of God's love for us and our need for God.

On this Feast of Corpus Christi let us remember in gratitude the faith that has been handed onto us through the generations. The symbols of bread and wine continue to be the way by which we overcome our regrets, our guilt, our lack of love, and we are reminded again that you and I are precious in the eyes of God.

The Cemetery gates and a portion of the railing along the Dundalk Road, will be removed in the coming days for sandblasting & painting and will subsequently be re-instated. Grass cutting for 2023 has finally commenced and will be ongoing across the summer and autumn months.
