Weekly Reflection.

Ascension – reason for our hope!

When Jesus ascended into heaven, the disciples were for a time at a loss as to what to do next. After the Resurrection Jesus had been present with them for 40 days but now, He was gone from their sight and so the angel asked, 'Why are you men from Gallilee staring into the sky?' It took some time for the realisation to become clear that the Resurrection itself would be worthless if there was not a return by Jesus to the Father, to a fullness of life with God in Heaven.

The Resurrection of the dead and life everlasting is the basis of the disciple's faith, and of our own faith too, which we profess in the Creed. While each of us has or will experience the loss of a loved one in death, the heartbreaking pain we experience is made more manageable with our faith that their death is not the end of everything, but the beginning of an eternal happiness with God in Heaven.

This feast of the Ascension reminds us of the reason for our hope. That in the Ascension Jesus has gone ahead to prepare a place for us in the fullness of the Kingdom. Where He has gone, we hope to follow.
