Weekly Reflection.

'Saying Thanks'

When I was a child, I was extremely fortunate to have a generous aunt nursing in England who herself having never married, took every opportunity to shower her nephews and nieces with gifts. In the summertime she would visit for two weeks and having never heard of travelling light she would arrive with an enormous number of red suitcases many of which were packed with toys and presents for the children in our house. We longed for the day of her arrival and could hardly contain ourselves with the prospects of what wonderful gifts might have our names on it. Then it was so easy for us to say 'Thanks' on the spot and tear off to enjoy our newfound toys.

When she returned to England, she would never forget our birthdays and with the card arriving in the post there was always a generous postal order for the birthday boy or girl. That was great, but the dread then was that my mother would insist on us writing a 'thank-you letter' by return of post. This was so difficult and cumbersome. What to say to the aunt who was so kind to us stretched our limited vocabulary to breaking point. What had we to say other than the word 'thanks. Still the letter had to be written.

Years later, my aunt told us our 'thank-you letters' were the happiest mail she ever received and she treasured them greatly, and so we realised that a meaningful 'Thank you' is worth an awful lot. Jesus has the same opinion in the story of the ten people with leprosy. We should occasionally compile a 'thank-you letter' to God for His blessings to us. And while we are at it a word of thanks to all who are kind to us in any way.

Prayers for the Pre-Synodal Assembly of the Catholic Church in Ireland.

All Catholics are invited to pray for a special gathering that will take place in Kilkenny on 18th October, called a Pre-Synodal Assembly of the Catholic Church in Ireland. This assembly is an important juncture on the journey towards a National Synodal Assembly to be held in 2026. Around 240 people will be in attendance and these are drawn from each diocese on the island, Religious Congregations and Church movements. A preparatory document, entitled *Baptised and Sent* - the fruits of listening sessions across Ireland last spring - will be the basis for discussion at this gathering, and for the next stage of the journey of renewal. Central to the document is a renewed focus on baptism as the foundation of our Christian dignity, unity, and mission and how baptism infuses the life and mission of the Church in Ireland today and into the future.
