#### Weekly Reflection.

#### "The last person they expected to see."

"The disciples told their story...." is how the Gospel begins today. Their story is of their meeting with Jesus on the road to Emmaus. They could have honestly said He was the last person they expected to meet on the road!

There is an excitement and confusion among the disciples – the Risen Jesus is appearing to them, and they are overjoyed but afraid to believe and so repeatedly Jesus says, "Do not be afraid!" Jesus appears to the disciples in the room and walks in their midst. He wants them to feel him, to touch him, to be convinced that He is real. He is God who wants to walk with us and amongst us. He wishes to accompany us on our journey through life.

Pope Francis is a great man for connecting with people – he follows in the footsteps of Jesus by being present to ordinary people wherever he goes. A friend who recently visited St Peter's Square told me of how Pope Francis lifted a young Down Syndrome boy and took him in the "Popemobile" as it was driven around the Square – it is a powerful image of the respect that the Pope shows to all people, especially those whose special needs are less obvious then our own. Can you imagine the excitement of the boy and his family!

When Pope Francis came to Dublin, to Croke Park a few years ago I had the good fortune to be present and to experience at first hand the power of his presence and his words – you could say he was the last person you would expect to see there!

Let us give thanks and praise to God, for living among us, and giving us Pope Francis to guide and direct us.
