## Weekly Reflection.

# "Where is Jesus to be found?"

The question behind today's Gospel is the eternal question – Where is Jesus to be found?

The answer is as it was then – not in the physical presence of Jerusalem 2000 years ago, but in the believing faith community, and in every person within that community.

How he is to be found then is similar to how we find the air that we breathe. The word "Spirit" means "breath" – the oxygen we breathe is unseen but it keeps us alive, without it we'd die. So too with the Holy Spirit – it is the unseen breath of God that enables us to live, to love, to hope, and to pray, without it our lives would be unfulfilled.

As the psalmist says – "I thank you Lord for the wonder of my being".

We thank God that he is to be found within us, and in the faith community, gathered to celebrate the Sunday Eucharist.

The route this year will be as follows, starting from St Joseph's Church Carrickmacross at 3pm - turning to Farney Street, down by the Convent, via Mullinary, turning right towards Parnell Street, toward Main Street, turn Right at Main Street towards O'Neill Street back to St Joseph's, Benediction will take place outside St Joseph's Church at approximately 4pm.
