'Moved with compassion'

In the Gospel Jesus is moved with compassion to the plight of the harassed, poor and deprived whom he encountered. He called the apostles and sent them out to care for their needs. Christ's call is to each one of us wherever we find ourselves to be His witnesses in the world. The Cemetery gates and a portion of the railing along the Dundalk Road, will be removed in the coming days for sandblasting & painting and will subsequently be re-instated. Grass cutting for 2023 has finally commenced and will be ongoing across the summer and autumn months.
