#### Our Catholic schools.

Catholic Schools Week begins today 21<sup>st</sup> January and runs to the 28<sup>th</sup>January. The theme is "Communities of Service." Jesus was called teacher forty-six times in the Gospel and his instruction to his followers was "Go teach all nations." What did Jesus teach?
