#### "Looking into the Sky!"

"Don't be standing there with your mouth open" was an expression from my youth that I have not heard in a while. It was said occasionally by my late father to myself and my brothers when we would be all excited when a new tractor or piece of machinery would arrive on the farm. He preferred that we would get on with our work rather than standing idly admiring the new machine.

In the First Reading today from the Acts of the Apostles, the angels challenge the disciples to stop standing looking into the sky when Jesus had ascended into Heaven. They were being urged to get back to their work; they would find Jesus present in the community where his ideals were being lived.

Sometimes we get caught up looking for the exceptional, for the miraculous, to find God. There is no need to do so. God is to be found in the everyday bits and pieces of life, when the gifts of the Holy Spirit are put into action.

The Cemetery gates and a portion of the railing along the Dundalk Road, will be removed in the coming days for sandblasting & painting and will subsequently be re-instated. Grass cutting for 2023 has finally commenced and will be ongoing across the summer and autumn months. However, we need substantial assistance with strimming and weeding of path borders and other communal areas. Therefore, we are seeking volunteers to assist with these tasks.
