### **Weekly Reflection.**

### 'Wheeling and dealing!'

Some years back there was a television comedy called 'Only fools and horses' whose central character Del-boy was a small-time, fly-by-night, wheeler dealer who dreamt that one day his endeavours would make him rich. 'This time next year we will be millionaires' was proclaimed in whatever shady enterprise he had thought up, usually just before the latest wheeze would collapse in ignominious failure.

Jesus seems to be commending just such attributes in the Gospel today when the parable he tells praises the dishonest steward, who when faced with financial disaster uses all his astuteness, to arrive at a comfortable living following his dismissal from office.

Jesus is not suggesting any such rascality in our dealings with others. What he is recommending is that instead of exerting might and mane to achieve riches in this world, each of us should put strenuous efforts into achieving a spiritual dividend in this life so that we may assemble treasures in Heaven.

So no, our goal is not that of Del-boy.

## <u>Sacred Heart Crusade</u> – The 2025 Jubilee Year of Hope.

The late Pope Francis, who opening the **Jubilee Year of Hope** at St. Peter's Basilica in Rome on Christmas Eve 2024, also blessed a number of **Pilgrim Statutes of the Sacred Heart of Jesus**.
