"Old Fashioned Commitment"

Leaving Certificate Students in our Secondary Schools are presently considering their options for life after school. The variety of options open to them is enormous. In older times the choice was fairly restricted; either apprenticeship for a trade or else University. Today there are literally thousands of courses available across a range of Colleges, Institutes, Universities, Businesses, etc, not to mention the option of a gap year. The challenge of trying to match their aspirations, their abilities and their opportunities is huge. But at the end of the day a choice has to be made, a decision taken. This is good training for life for one cannot drift along exploring options forever. Sooner or later the possibilities have to be narrowed down and a commitment made.
