#### "Centre Stage"

All over the Christian World there have been Nativity Plays taking place from our local primary school production with shy, reluctant actors, right the way to major stage productions with well-experienced thespians. Common to all of them is the fundamental role played by the Virgin Mary.

There is a beautiful moment in one of Monteverdi's concerts where the entire company of Heaven, from God the Father, through the saints, and all the angels are aware of the enormous task given to the Angel Gabriel as he is sent to Mary in Nazareth to give her the news that she is to give birth to Jesus. All of heaven comes to a standstill, this is the greatest moment in history, the excitement and the tension rises to a crescendo, culminating in a silence as "heaven holds its breath" – what will be her response? What if she says no?

Then Mary speaks the gentle words – "let what you have said be done to me" and the music and singing and orchestra reverberates in loud and joyful celebration – from one end of heaven to the other – "all will be well."
