#### Weekly Reflection.

#### "Lord I am not worthy"

There is a conundrum at play in our understanding of God. Sometimes we believe we can endeavour to deserve God's love, but then we hear that God's love is unconditional.

Before we receive Holy Communion at Mass we say the words "Lord I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof" and then we get upset if someone who we deem to be really "unworthy" has the audacity to receive. Pope Francis wisely counsels that Holy Communion is the nourishment for the sinner, not a prize for the virtuous.

Jesus' Gospel story today is challenging – I can feel like the one who has laboured all day, and the Johnny-come-lately gets the same as me!

God's message for us is to realise that all we have – talent, brains, skill, privilege is a gift we have been given – it is not intended as a source of pride.

### St. Joseph's Cemetery – Sept '23 Update

As you will be aware, the first draft of our new 'Cemetery Display Board & Map' has been available to view in the front porch of St. Joseph's Church Carrickmacross since Thurs 29<sup>th</sup> June '23. In our July '23 update, we invited anyone who wished to make changes / additions, to do so by completing and signing an 'Alterations Form', which were made available from the Parish Office. The original cut-off date for making changes / additions was Fri 28<sup>th</sup> July '23, however this date was extended – the new cut-off date for changes / additions to the 'Display Board' is Thurs 14<sup>th</sup> Sept '23. You may also recall that in our May '23 update, the Cemetery Committee invited any individual /

organisation who would like to 'adopt' one of this year's improvement projects, and fundraise for same, to contact the Committee Chairman Patrick Doherty. We are delighted to announce that two families responded to this call and have 'adopted' the Cemetery Display Board between them - this will be recognised on the Display Board when erected. The Display Board will be erected in the Cemetery in late September / early October 2023.

The laurel hedge which surrounds a substantial portion of the Cemetery perimeter, will be trimmed, and faced later on this month, while other general maintenance activities such as grass cutting and weed control are ongoing – these tasks were especially challenging this year given the very wet summer we experienced.

The Cemetery Committee would like to reinforce the message that, **"No Dogs or Pets are permitted in the Cemetery at any time"** – accordingly, signs have been erected throughout the Cemetery.
