Weekly Reflection.

"Back from the dead"

Lazarus is one of the most familiar characters of the Gospels. The miracle that Jesus worked in bringing him back from the dead has held the imagination of so many people down through the centuries. Almost every significant sporting comeback is described as being comparable to the Lazarus story, and every unlikely victory be it in business, finance or even in terms of human health, is often seen in the context of Lazarus' resurrection.

I prefer to focus on a much more mundane interpretation of today's Gospel. Jesus commands Lazarus with the words "Come out of the tomb". He is calling us too to come out of our own tombs – tombs of selfishness, or comfort, or complacency, or ignorance, or laziness. Today Jesus is calling us out of our self-centeredness so that we rediscover the joy of generosity and love, and find a life that is both fulfilling and rewarding.
