Weekly Reflection.

'The hearth fire'

Before global warming was heard of most houses had an open-hearth fire. In the winter evenings it was pleasant to sit before the fire and experience the warmth and homeliness that it provided. Occasionally a coal might fall from the fire to the hearth. As it lay on the hearth the red glow would start to disappear until it became a just a cold piece of coal. Only when lifted with the tongs back onto the fire would it start to glow again.

I often think of the church in this way. Those who come to Mass and celebrate as a Christian community share in the warmth and homeliness of our faith. Those who drop out or drift away from Mass gradually lose that sense of belonging and the glow that is shared here in our churches starts to fade.

As we look towards Christmas perhaps, we could invite someone we know who has slipped away from the Mass to return and share with us in the warmth of our faith community.
