"Catholic Schools Week"

This past week we have celebrated our Catholic Schools and it gives us an opportunity to reflect on the benefits that Catholic education provides for our communities. We accept that a good education begins in the home. At Baptism ceremonies the parents take on the responsibility of teaching their children about God the Father, about Jesus Christ and about the Holy Spirit. They accept responsibility for teaching their children how to pray, and promise to be "the best of teachers" by the example they give in their own lives.

The Catholic School then is an extension of the home and it provides a safe environment where the child discovers for themselves a relationship with God through the exploration of creation, and learns that the God of creation is a loving and caring presence in their lives.

Pope Francis asks us to consider "care for our planet" as an opportunity to reflect that our world is a gift from God.
