Weekly Reflection.

'And a sword will pierce your soul'

The Presentation of the Lord introduces us to Simeon and Anna, the elderly religious couple who are overjoyed at their encounter with the child Jesus and His parents Mary and Joseph, in the Temple. They have lived their entire lives for this moment and the exuberance of their words is beautifully spoken and recorded and have become part of our prayers ever since.

However, there is one phrase at which I always stumble, and it is the words of Anna to Mary 'and a sword will pierce your soul.' This is quite a harsh and indeed cruel turn of phrase, and it warned Mary of the perils that lay ahead of her when Jesus would suffer humiliation and death. But then again, many parents endure similar pain when their son or daughter becomes ill, suffers an accident, or dies at an early age. Parents in these situations will know the meaning of the phrase. Parents who look helplessly on their child suffering addiction or experiences rejection will know too the pain of the sword in one's soul.

The consolation for these parents is that they are in the special company of Mary, our Blessed Mother, when such pain comes their way.
