#### Weekly Reflection.

#### 'A Sword will pierce your soul.'

I believe these words of Simeon to Mary on the occasion of the Presentation of Jesus in the Temple have been echoed down the centuries when doctors tell the parents of a newborn baby that their child has special needs.

Phil Coulter, the great Derry songwriter had a son Paul who was Downes Syndrome. Phil did not know how to cope with this 'gift' from God and for months he struggled to come to terms with the sense of anguish and devastation experienced by both he and his wife. It was then that he wrote a most powerful song about his beautiful and beloved child. Paul died at the age of four but in his short life he gave Coulter a glimpse and an insight into these special messengers from God.

'Scorn not his simplicity' is a favourite of mine especially the version sung by the late Luke Kelly. On this Feast of the Holy Family, you might seek out the song and try to understand the magnificence of God in the lives of these signs of contradiction.
