Weekly Reflection.

Protecting the family.

In the Gospel today Jesus clears the temple of the moneychangers as he sets about protecting the sanctity of the temple. In two weeks' time we are being called to protect and defend the sanctity of the family and of motherhood. Our government would have us diminish the unique importance of the relationship between marriage and the family and to abolish all reference to motherhood in the constitution.

I believe this is an assault on role of the family as the foundation stone of our society, and I believe that families are the glue that holds us to a common good and should be promoted and protected. The term 'durable relationship' is a nonsense that defies explanation in legal terms. The role of mothers should be cherished because of the incalculable contribution that all mothers make to the family, the home and society. Pope John Paul said, 'The family is the true measure of the greatness of the nation.'

Like Jesus in the temple, we are called today defend and protect inalienable values. We must preserve and foster the dignity and value of family life and motherhood.
