# St. Joseph's Cemetery – Feb '24 Update.

Just a short note to update you on our Cemetery Improvement Projects which were started in 2023.

- ➤ Cemetery Lighting The first part of this project is now complete. The lights at the top of the Cemetery and along the Angel Plot were switched on, on Wed 1<sup>st</sup> Nov '23 feedback has been very positive. We are currently investigating the feasibility of installing additional lights half ways up the main driveway across from the mini carpark.
- ➤ The access gates at Calvary will be removed at some stage during February for sandblasting and painting and will be promptly replaced thereafter. Work on painting the remainder of the Cemetery railing will be completed in stages during 2024.
- The Cemetery Map Display Board will be located on the green area adjacent to the St. Louis Plots. Ground works to prepare this area for the Map Board will be worked on across March '24 our aim is to have this project completed by the end of April '24
