Weekly Reflection.

Lord, 'Increase our faith.'

Today's gospel reading opens with the apostles saying to Jesus – Lord, 'Increase our faith.' The words 'Increase our faith' could be spoken by any one of us these days, in that it acknowledges that we have faith but that our faith is, at times, weak and vulnerable.

The response of Jesus to the apostles is striking, 'Were your faith the size of a mustard seed......'
It is as if Jesus is saying to the apostles, 'Even a little faith is something powerful. I can work powerfully in and through faith that is as small as a mustard seed.' I am reminded of Saint Paul's statement in one of his letters that the Lord's power is made perfect in weakness. A little opening is all the Lord needs. Even though our faith seems weak at times, we should never devalue our little faith, because the Lord values it highly.

So, with the apostles we can simply pray, 'Lord, increase our faith.' Or in other term, 'Lord, deepen my relationship with you. Help me to respond more fully to your call. Empower me to become the person you want me to be.'
