The commissioning of new and existing Eucharistic Ministers will take place in St Joseph's Church, on Friday 27th October at the 7.30pm evening Mass.

The Synod on Synodality: takes place from 4th – 29th October in Rome, on the theme: 'For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation, Mission'. The aim of the Synodal Process is to provide an opportunity for the entire People of God to discern together how to move forward towards being a more synodal Church in the long-term.
